



Speaking Parts for the Performance

Instructions: Child 2 and 3 enter, talking with each other. Child 1 enters behind them and stands next to child 3, trying to tower over him/her.

- Child 1: Hey there, shrimp.
- Child 2: That's not very nice! *Child 3* can't help it if he's (she's) not as tall as you.
- Child 3: And besides, I'm still growing! I'm two inches taller than I was last year.
- Child 1: Well, you'll never be as tall as me!
- Child 3: Compared to God, we're all pretty small. God is bigger than anybody or anything.
- Child 1: How do you know that? You've never seen God.
- Child 2: No, but he's (she's) seen what God can do. He created the universe and everything in it. You have to be pretty big to do that.
- Child 3: He keeps all the planets where they're supposed to be. He causes the sun to come up every morning, and the stars to come out at night. He knows what is happening all over the world at this very minute!
- Child 1: God must be pretty busy. I wonder if He has time for all that.
- Child 2: God is so powerful that He can do anything. He's so big that nothing is too hard for Him. The Bible says so!
- Child 3: And He doesn't care if I'm short or tall. He loves me just the same.
- Child 1: I guess you're right.
- Child 2: She sure is!
- Child 3: The next time you have a problem, ask God to take care of it. Then you'll see how big God *really* is. Lots bigger than you and me.
- Choir: *(Recites.)* Psalm 18:2— "The Lord is my rock, and my fortress, and my deliverer; my God, my strength, in whom I will trust; my buckler, and the horn of my salvation, *and* my high tower."
- Choir: *(Sings.)* "Our God Is Bigger"
